The vases of iris flowers with vines and leaves are made and ready for use when there is a problem It appears that they are seldom needed. That is good news.

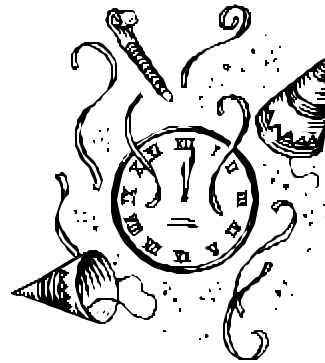
JOSH Dogs
